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HELPFUL TIPS ON HOW TO ENJOY THE FESTIVAL

After two decades, the Mattie Kelly Arts Foundation (MKAF) will present the 21st Annual Festival of the Arts. Over 100 fine artists from the U.S. and Europe will showcase their original art, ranging from acrylic, clay, collage, glass, jewelry, metal, mosaic, mixed media, oil, pen and ink, pastel, photography, digital art, pottery, sculpture, fiber, wood and watercolor. To help navigate your way through the 21st Annual Festival of the Arts, here are some helpful tips ...

FESTIVAL VENUE

4323 Commons Drive West - Destin

Located in the heart of Destin, directly north of Henderson Beach State Park and two miles west of Destin Commons, the festival sits on seven acres of green space. A stunning 22-foot contemporary metal sculpture designed by artist Frank Ledbetter welcomes guests into the Cultural Arts Village.

FESTIVAL HOURS & ADMISSION

Festival hours are 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. on Saturday and 10:00 am to 4:00 p.m. on Sunday. Admission is \$5 per adult per day and free to MKAF members and children 12 and under. The admission cost supports funding for MKAF cultural events and art education outreach initiatives.

FREE FESTIVAL PARKING

Free parking is available adjacent to the Cultural Arts Village at Grace Lutheran Church. Additional overflow parking with free continuous art shuttle service is available at Emerald Coast Centre, located across from the Henderson Beach State Park, near Beall's Department Store. The Cultural Arts Village is designed as an ADA compliant venue with available handicap parking.

ARTIST BOOTHS

More than 100 premier artists from the U.S. and Europe, including a local student/adult Collaborative Art Exhibit, will landscape the Village Green in their white-topped tents to display their original works of art. Artist booths are numbered to correspond with artists listed in the guide on pages 15, 16, 17, 20, 21, and 22.

PLEIN AIR PAINTERS

In the mid 19th century, working in natural light became particularly important to the Barbizon School and Impressionism. En plein air is a French expression meaning "in the open air" used to describe the act of painting outdoors. Visit the Plein Air Painters in Booth #16 featuring several local artists: Jim Clark, Judy Jean Dewar, Russell Ferris, Celeste Jones, Leslie Morris, Rosalyn O'Grady & Patti Overholt.

FESTIVAL AWARDS & JUDGES

Nancy Raia, Community Arts Director Eastern Shore Art and Jerry Johnson, Professor of Art and Design, Troy University, will award \$10,000 in artist prizes in the juried and collaborative art categories. Festival fans will vote on Saturday for the coveted "People's Choice" artist award and drop ballots at the Main Festival Entrance.

ARTSTOP – FREE KID'S ART ACTIVITIES

Kids can discover their artistic flare in the ArtStop Tent sponsored by Silver Sands Premium Outlets. Create your own works of art in a variety of free hands-on interactive art activities featuring mural making, pumpkin and face painting. Children must be accompanied by a parent or guardian.

Cuisine on the Green will serve up samplings of gumbo and savory seafood from 790 On The Gulf, street tacos from The Big Red Truck, barbeque from Jim N' Nicks, Asian/Caribbean fusion from Coastal Chow, Kettle Corn from Rosey's Sweets and Treats and JK Italian Ice. 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guest artist *A.J. Brown*

Second generation Florida Highwayman

A beautiful example of art transcending time is found in the story of Florida Highwaymen. This year the Festival welcomes guest artist A.J. Brown, 64, a second generation Florida Highwayman from Fort Pierce, Florida.

The original Highwaymen were 26 self-taught African American painters, who in the 1950s realized that they couldn't sell their work in white-owned galleries, so they took to the road selling their scenes of beaches, sea and wildlife for \$25 from their car trunks on area roadways. Today, many of the remaining Highwaymen are still on the road selling their works, but thankfully the world is more welcoming and their art is highly valued selling for thousands of dollars.

Born in Virginia, raised by a single mother and Seminole Indian grandmother in southern Florida, Brown came from a family of migrant fruit and vegetable pickers from Tallahassee, Florida. Life was hard. These nomadic working families lived in camps and traveled from highway to highway. During Brown's elementary school years, she, like many others, attended more than 10 different schools and had 15 different home addresses. "We had no permanent home. We were Highwaymen in every sense of the word," Brown says.

During 1969 Brown was in the fourth grade at Means Court Elementary School. When school recessed she worked summer jobs include being a stucco helper to her Uncle Alfred's and picking oranges in the fields. "We all were searching for a way out," Brown says. "We were all caught in the same economic inequality."

In the 1960s the family set roots in the Lincoln Park area of Fort Pierce, Florida. The Civil Rights Movement was growing in Miami as it was throughout the

country. Brown and her family would once again be on the move. "I was among the first students to end segregation. In 1970, early before day break, I woke to take three buses out of my neighborhood and across town to desegregate, one white school in another town."

Brown's life, like many Florida Highwaymen, is clearly illustrated in her work. Images of vividly colored Red Royal Poinciana and Purple Jacaranda trees along the southern bayous of Florida are trademarks.

The history of Highwaymen is a part of our collective American history. And their rightful place in the world of art was confirmed recently when President Barack Obama and the First Lady added two of Brown's paintings to their personal collection. And the tradition transcends time as art history is passed down to the next generation, including Brown's own granddaughter, Jalisa.
